HIPAA Exception Pilot Proves Significant Improvement: How Using FHIR APIs Streamlines Prior Authorization

After inquiries and feedback from membership, the HL7 Da Vinci Project requested and received approval in 2021 for an exception to HIPAA requirements for Da Vinci payers and their trading partners when using the FHIR standard for prior authorization, allowing members to test new versions of standards to prove out the ability of the HL7 FHIR® standard for Prior Authorization (PA) to improve efficiency and further achieve administrative simplification as envisioned by the HIPAA regulations. Through the exception testing, Da Vinci was able to demonstrate that the HL7 FHIR-based standards for PA significantly improved the prior authorization process in comparison to the existing standard. Presenters will share the lessons learned and significant outcomes of the testing, including how using FHIR APIs enabled the organizations to achieve an improvement of 140% or more in the time it took to complete individual point-to-point transactions.
