With a focus on advancing standards for electronic administrative transactions, promoting data privacy and security, WEDI has been instrumental in aligning the industry to harmonize administrative and clinical data.

Since January 2024, WEDI has hosted nearly a dozen virtual educational events focusing on the planning, testing and overall implementation of CMS-0057F. The spotlights, which has attracted thousands of health care stakeholders, have focused on education and guidance led by national subject matter experts, supporting health plans, providers, vendors, and other stakeholders as they begin their implementation plans.
